Draw 2 blue birds inside the box:

The hungry birds saw five tasty crackers on the ground.

Both of them wanted to all of the crackers for themselves!

Draw 5 crackers:

The bluebirds argued over which bird was going to eat the crackers. As they fought, four little puppies gobbled up all of the crackers!


Draw 4 cuddly puppies:

Now the bluebirds were very sad, and even *more* hungry than before! They apologized to eat other and decided to fly across town looking for food to share. Beside an old shed they found eight big brown bags full of birdseed!

Draw 8 bags of bird seed:

The hungry birds were *just* about to start arguing over who was going to get to eat all the birdseed when they saw ten colorful ducks flying in the distance towards them.

Draw 10 ducks:



The bluebirds looked at each other and flew over to the bird seed. Instead of being greedy, they only took four bags of birdseed to eat and left the rest for the ducks! The hungry ducks were so happy that the bluebirds shared the birdseed with them!

In fact, the ducks were so thankful for the birdseed that they left the bluebirds two presents in little boxes.
